These programs - spanning everything from case management, one-on-one counseling, community workshops, health assessments, treatment planning, crisis intervention, and more - are aimed at supporting residents and promoting self-sufficiency.

Founded in 1990, HomeRise (formerly Community Housing Partnership) is an award-winning San Francisco nonprofit dedicated to helping people experiencing homelessness secure housing and become self-sufficient. As a dynamic service organization, HomeRise pairs affordable housing with support services, employment preparation, job training, a transitional employment social enterprise, and community organizing activities. Together these services offer San Francisco's most-vulnerable residents a direct pathway from homelessness to self-sufficiency. HomeRise utilizes safe, stable housing as a platform to deliver services to clients which help promote both increased self-sufficiency as well as long-term retention of housing. HomeRise owns, manages, or provides services at 18 buildings with over 1,500 units and has 140 additional new units in development. HomeRise's housing and services annually impact the lives of nearly 2,000 formerly homeless adults, seniors, veterans, and children.
